The Beginning of the End: A Series in Mark | "Denial, Denial, Denial"

Read Mark 14:66-72

- 1. The sermon stated that self-preservation is "the antithesis of self-denial." In what areas of your life do you find yourself most tempted toward self-preservation over self-denial? What are the driving motivations behind that?
- 2. Which of the three practical rhythms for self-denial (service, solitude, Sabbath) resonates with you the most? Which one feels most challenging? Discuss practical ways your group could spur one another on in these rhythms.
- 3. Have you ever, like Peter, experienced a moment of self-denial failure? What did you learn from that experience about the necessity of God's grace? How can we extend that same grace to others?
- 4. Brandon said, "the longer you're with Jesus, the deeper the relationship gets, the more the world can say: 'they've been with Jesus!'" What specific actions, habits or attributes mark someone who has clearly "been with Jesus"?
- 5. Why is self-denial actually positive and life-giving, rather than merely sacrifice? How have you experienced paradoxical joy or freedom through denying yourself for Christ's sake?
