**The Art of Grappling with God:** A Summer Series in Habakkuk | “Utterly Amazed”

### Read Habakkuk 1:1-11

1. The sermon series is titled "The Art of Grappling with God." What does it mean to you to "grapple" with God? Share about a time when you wrestled with God about a difficult question or circumstance. How did that experience impact your relationship with Him?
2. Brandon said, “God doesn't have a ceiling for what we can bring to Him.” Do you ever feel like you need to censor or qualify your prayers before God? How does the range of prayers in the Psalms (lament, imprecatory, praise, etc.) encourage you to be more authentic in prayer?
3. Despite the unfaithfulness of His people, God is described as a “covenant-keeping” or a “promise-keeping” God. What are some of God's promises that you cling to when you're walking through a season of doubt or discouragement? How have you seen God's faithfulness to His promises in your own life?
4. Habakkuk was deeply troubled by the violence and injustice he saw in Judah. As believers, how are we called to respond to injustice in our world today? What is the role of prayer and action in addressing injustice issues?
5. The sermon ended by marveling at the amazing grace of God demonstrated in Christ. Share about a time when you were utterly amazed by God's grace in your life. How can we cultivate a continual posture of amazement at the gospel, even in the mundane or difficult moments of life?
